OUR 2025

During 2025, at ITURRI Foundation we have continued to promote our mission of contributing to a **safer and more sustainable world**, collaborating with professionals and organizations to support people and communities in vulnerable situations.



EMERGENCIES
AND DISASTERS

Throughout the year, we have been involved in **two emergency responses** and have strengthened our capacity by **refurbishing an emergency vehicle**.



PREVENTION
& SAFETY

In the field of preparedness and protection, we trained and equipped **40 forest firefighters** in Brazil and donated personal protective equipment (PPE) to **1,220 people**, 390 of whom are emergency response professionals.



SOCIAL ACTION

In response to the emergency caused by the **DANA** (Valencia, Spain), we have contributed to the recovery of the local business community by donating uniforms and **PPE to 400 small and medium-sized enterprises**, also strengthening their safety.



ENVIRONMENT

Additionally, we donated four **stair evacuation chairs** to improve the autonomy of people with reduced mobility living in buildings where elevators are still not operational.

OUR 2025

In terms of prevention and protection of vulnerable groups, we installed **75 smoke detectors** in the homes of elderly people experiencing unwanted loneliness, complementing the intervention with awareness-raising and home safety training activities.

In the area of workplace prevention, we promoted **awareness of suicide prevention** through the development and dissemination of the Suicide Prevention Guide, with more than 300 attendees at its presentations (Seville, Barcelona, and Madrid).

Likewise, in regions such as the Brazilian Amazon, Ukraine, and Madagascar, among others, we have promoted access to basic resources by distributing **4,000 water filters**, helping to improve the health and safety of families without access to safe drinking water.

Our corporate commitment has also been strengthened through the participation of **80 ITURRI volunteers** in **5 initiatives** throughout the year, reinforcing our culture of solidarity.

Through these actions, in 2025 we have reaffirmed our commitment to prevention, the protection of people, and emergency response, helping to build safer environments.

HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS

INSTALLATION OF SMOKE DETECTORS



In 2024, **234 people died in Spain due to fires or explosions**. Most of these deaths occur in the home, especially at night, when early fire detection is more difficult.

In response to this reality, we have launched a **home fire prevention project** aimed at protecting vulnerable elderly people. The initiative combines the **installation** of smoke detectors in homes with **awareness-raising and self-protection training**, strengthening household safety and improving emergency response capacity.

From Seville, we are implementing this project in collaboration with Cruz Roja Andalucía and PRODEAN, with the support of the Seville Association of Veteran Firefighters. During 2025, the initiative has helped protect **75 households of elderly people in particularly vulnerable neighborhoods** such as Los Pajaritos and La Macarena (Sevilla).

Following these results, we aim to progressively replicate this initiative in other cities such as Valencia, Granada, and Málaga to expand the number of protected households.

HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS

SUICIDE PREVENTION GUIDE



In collaboration with the Spanish Red Cross, Teléfono de la Esperanza, the Catalan Association for Suicide Prevention (ACPS), and Affor Health, we have developed a pioneering guide to address **suicide prevention within the workplace**.

Suicide is the **leading cause of external death in Spain**, with an average of 11 deaths per day. According to WHO data, more than **700,000 people die** by suicide worldwide each year. The workplace, where we spend a large part of our lives, can become a key setting for the **early detection** of emotional distress and **preventive intervention**.

This guide is specifically aimed at companies, Human Resources teams, and Occupational Health and Safety professionals. It provides practical tools, key data, and strategies to **identify risk signals**, act in time, and **support people in crisis situations**.

Its goal is to promote more humane, safe, and mentally healthy work environments.

HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS

The Guide has been presented in Seville, Madrid, and Barcelona, with more than **300 attendees** from different national companies. During these presentations, the content of the Guide was shared, and key concepts such as the myths and realities surrounding suicide were explored in greater depth. We were joined by leading professionals who helped present and raise awareness among the audience at each event.

Throughout the sessions, we emphasized the importance of **everyone being able to act as prevention agents**, provided they receive proper training and know how to use the available tools effectively.

This initiative reflects our commitment to **promoting mental health and well-being in all areas of society**. By fostering open conversations and reducing stigma around suicide, we aim to create supportive environments where individuals feel safe to seek help and where prevention becomes a shared responsibility.

HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS

REFURBISHMENT OF VEHICLES

The war in Ukraine, now in its fourth year, continues to cause a major humanitarian crisis. In municipalities such as Fastiv, in the center of the country, shelling has increased the risk of fires in silos and grain storage facilities.

In response to this situation, the ITURRI Foundation, in collaboration with Firefighters United Without Borders (BUSF), has facilitated the **delivery of a water tanker fire truck with a capacity of 9,000 liters to State Fire Company No. 30 of Ukraine**. Through this initiative, we are strengthening their operational capacity and emergency response, especially in high-risk fire scenarios.

The vehicle was **refurbished at our facilities in Alcalá de Henares** to ensure it meets the technical and operational requirements for deployment in the field. For its transfer to Ukraine, we worked in collaboration with the **Spanish Center of Ukraine** and with the support of the **Embassy of Ukraine** in Spain.

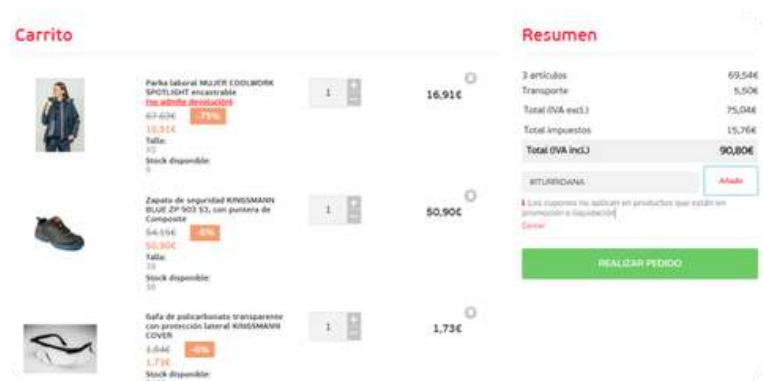
POST-DANA ACTIONS

Throughout 2025, we have continued to support the communities affected by the October 2024 DANA. In collaboration with the Spanish Red Cross, we have implemented various support and recovery initiatives.

Donation of **stair evacuation chairs**. Four evacuation chairs have been delivered to facilitate the transport of people who have been left isolated in their buildings due to the lack of elevators. In many buildings, these have still not been repaired following the damage suffered. It is estimated that, in just one year, this equipment has been used more than 5,600 times, **improving mobility and access to care for people with limited movement**.

Donation of uniforms and protective equipment for affected businesses. Through ITURRI's e-commerce platform, a system was set up to allow affected businesses to independently and free of charge request essential equipment. This initiative has supported the recovery of small businesses, benefiting **more than 400 companies**.

We continue working to ensure that no one is left behind.



VOLUNTEER ACTIONS

We carried out five volunteer initiatives with the participation of more than **80 ITURRI volunteers**, including family members and friends of our colleagues. We believe in the importance of volunteering as a way to stay connected with the different realities that exist within our society.

FOOD COLLECTION

In 2025, we took part in two food collection campaigns organized by the Seville Food Bank, managing to gather a total of **6,190 kilograms of food for families in vulnerable situations across the province**. The Seville Food Bank, active since 1995, plays a fundamental role in recovering surplus food and distributing it to those most in need. Thanks to initiatives like these, thousands of families are able to meet their basic needs every day.

More than **50 ITURRI employees** participated in these initiatives, reflecting the company's commitment to local social action. In addition, this type of activity has a particularly meaningful impact on children, helping to promote values such as solidarity, empathy, and altruism.



VOLUNTEER ACTIONS

SUPPORT FOR ELDERLY PEOPLE

We carried out **two volunteer activities** with elderly people experiencing unwanted loneliness from the organization PRODEAN, in Los Pajaritos (Seville).

In May, we accompanied them on a **visit to the Basilica of Jesús del Gran Poder**. It was a very emotional visit during which several participants revisited meaningful life experiences. The Head Brother gave us a detailed explanation of the Basilica's history, allowing us to better understand the brotherhood.

At Christmas, they **visited our ITURRI headquarters**, guided by our volunteer colleagues. At the end of the visit, we shared a Christmas meal together, complete with traditional carols.

WASTE COLLECTION

In June, the ITURRI Valencia team took part in a volunteer day at Pinedo Beach, affected by the DANA, combining waste collection with an interpretive walk to discover the natural richness of the area.

EMERGENCY FUND

We responded to **2 emergencies**, continuing our support in the war in Ukraine and in Madagascar following the impact of a typhoon. We also maintained our support for communities affected by the DANA in Valencia.

FIREFIGHTING VEHICLE REFURBISHMENT

We refurbished **1 emergency vehicle**, a water tanker truck assigned to firefighting teams in Ukraine.

EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING

We trained and equipped **40 wildland firefighters** in the Amazon. In addition, **390 emergency response professionals** were provided with uniforms. We also donated rescue tools for USAR (Urban Search and Rescue) teams.

EMERGENCY PREVENTION

A total of **7,277 students and 1,676 teachers** benefited from natural hazard prevention training in Cuba, in the regions of Holguín and Guantánamo.

HOME SAFETY

We installed **75 smoke detectors** in the homes of vulnerable individuals. We supported healthcare institutions in Brazil, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and Senegal, directly benefiting more than **20 communities**. We also continued working on childhood burn prevention campaigns in Chile and Germany.

WORKPLACE SAFETY

We presented the Suicide Prevention Guide in three cities, with more than **300 attendees**. In addition, we held a webinar on suicide prevention featuring expert professionals.

We donated uniforms and PPE to various previously accredited organizations, benefiting more than **1,200 people**.

SUPPORT FOR VULNERABLE GROUPS

We participated in **early detection projects for Autism Spectrum Disorder** (Seville). We supported the care of elderly people in Poland by providing materials and specialized assistance.

We delivered **3,150 water filters** to families with limited access in Brazil, Ukraine, Madagascar, and Morocco.

We collaborated with food banks in Seville and Ecuador, promoting health through nutrition.

DONATION OF ESSENTIAL GOODS

Through local organizations, we have supported people in vulnerable situations. We donated **food, equipment, protective clothing, and toys** during the Christmas season. These actions have been carried out both in Spain and in Poland.

VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES

The following volunteer initiatives were carried out:

- Seville **Food Bank**: Spring and Christmas food collection campaigns.
- **Support for elderly people** in Los Pajaritos (Seville) with the organization PRODEAN. They visited our facilities at Christmas, and we accompanied them on a cultural visit in May.
- **Environmental volunteering** in Valencia together with Cruz Roja, in coastal areas affected by the DANA.

EDUCATION AND AWARENESS

We organized talks led by expert professionals to **promote awareness of climate change mitigation actions**. In 2025, we welcomed Carmen Llasat and Víctor Resco, both experts in climate change.

MITIGATION ACTIONS

We work with Amazonian communities to implement **integrated fire management practices** that combine indigenous knowledge with new technologies and tools. Together with local volunteer brigades, we collaborate on **prevention actions within the Amazon environment**.

In partnership with Hombre y Territorio, we have contributed to the **maintenance of ecosystems in Seville's Alamillo Park**. The impact has been significant, with visible improvements in the landscape as well as in the flora and fauna that inhabit it.



DEVELOPMENT AID

CHILD PROTECTION

We have collaborated with two local intervention organizations to protect children in highly vulnerable situations in Nepal and Colombia. A total of **318 families** benefit from these programs, which include both the refurbishment of a boarding school and the maintenance of shelters for children and young people.

Dream Nepal is a non-governmental organization that **rescues and cares for children** living in prison with their mothers, providing them with shelter, food, healthcare, and educational and psychosocial support, with the aim of ensuring a dignified development and better future opportunities.

Himali Boarding School is an educational institution in Nepal that offers a **safe environment and quality education**, thereby helping to improve opportunities for children in a particularly vulnerable context.
